Freelancer.com traffic up 40 percent in April, blasting into top 500 websites worldwide

SYDNEY, April 30, 2010 - Web traffic to Freelancer.com, the world's number one outsourcing marketplace, accelerated in April to an incredible 40 percent month on month growth, blasting it into the top 500 websites worldwide, according to Alexa.
